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ABOUT US



Enshrined within the timeless teachings of the Indian culture and philosophy, with a determined drive to educate, empower and enliven the dynamic youth of modern society, the Chinmaya International Residential School was envisioned by one of India's greatest spiritual luminaries Swami Chinmayananda, and established by his ardent devotee and the then head of Chinmaya Mission, Swami Tejomayananda, on the 6th of June 1996.

From its humble origins with just 94 students and eight teachers, it now hosts 120 staff members and 575 students, hailing from all the states of India and 27 other countries including USA, Singapore, Middle East, Chile, UK, Australia and Africa.

Affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education and the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) - Geneva, Switzerland, CIRS is currently headed by the Chairman Swami Swaroopananda, the Global head of Chinmaya Mission.

Cradled by the magnificent hills of the Western Ghats, the school boasts of an impressive campus of 80 acres with stunning flora and fauna. The serene view of the Velliangiri hill, combined with invigorating freshness of the CIRS culture, makes every student and parent to have nostalgic memories of the school for years. The campus has received the "Green School Award" by the Centre for Science and Environment, New Delhi. The school maintains a staff student ratio of 1:8 that ensures individual attention to every student towards holistic growth.

CBSE Curriculum



The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) is one of India's premier educational bodies offering qualifications to over 20,000 odd schools in 25 countries across the world currently.

CIRS is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Delhi (National Board) for both the All India Secondary School Examination (Grade X) and also the All India Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (Grade XII) since 1998.

Sharing a vision with CBSE, we provide shared knowledge experience to students from Grade V to Grade XII to enable academic, cultural and social mobility. The balanced, cross-disciplinary framework offered with concurrent subjects in sciences and humanities supports for the holistic development of students.

Children have the option to choose either CBSE or IB Curriculum in grade 11.

IB Diploma Curriculum



The International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IBDP) is a rigorous two-year course of study designed to prepare young men and women for the challenges of university studies and life beyond. CIRS is the 7th Indian School to be affiliated to the International Baccalaureate (IB), Geneva, Switzerland (Grades XI and XII). This qualification is recognized by Universities in India, Europe, America and Australia. Advanced placements and extra credit are offered by many Universities in the U.K., U.S.A., Canada and Australia. Some specific distinguishing characteristics of the IB Diploma Program are that it requires students to:

- Learn how to learn
- Develop an understanding of their own identity
- Nurture a sense of belonging within their own culture
- Communicate with and understand people from other countries and culture



Spiritual Curriculum
