1. If you do not pay the fee before the said date, it will be construed that you forfeit the seat and it will be offered to the next waitlisted candidates.

2. You should report for admission at 10.00 a.m. on 14.07.2014 (Monday) at SAC (Student Activity Centre) of this Institute along with the documents given in the Annexure. If you do not report for admission on this date, you may be liable to lose the seat. Please note that normally extension of date for admission is not possible and postal delays will not be entertained.
3. In case, if you do not accept this offer of admission, you are requested to inform the same immediately so that the waiting list can be operated.
4. You should submit Medical History Certificate in the format attached duly signed by the Authorized Medical Officer, after completing Master Health Check Up at the time of admission.
5. During the period of study when you are resident in the campus, the use of power vehicle inside the campus is strictly not allowed. This is with a view to keep our campus clean.
