I hope this life never ends!**



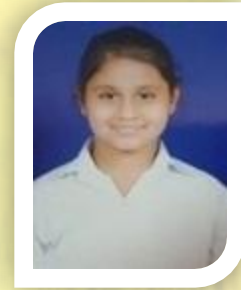

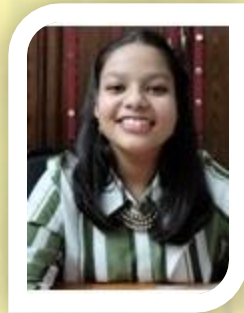
